Town of Red Hook Recreation Park Rules

The Town of Red Hook Recreation Park officially opens on 1 April and closes on 15 October every year. The Recreation Commission must approve permitted organizational uses beyond 15 October.

The following is an outline/description of all the rules of the Red Hook Recreation Park. Every group, league, program and organization must comply with these rules. It is the responsibility of the user representatives (organizers, officials, officers, managers, etc.) to ensure that all individual participants are made aware of the rules and practices of the Recreation Park.

Willful destruction of Recreation Park property will be fully compensated for by the group, league, program, or organization involved. The Town of Red Hook, the Red Hook Town Board, the Town of Red Hook Recreation Commission and its Directors and Groundskeepers will not be held liable for any damage to personal property or for any injury suffered during the course of the scheduled activity.

THE FOLLOWING RULES MUST BE OBSERVED:

- 1. HOURS** Park hours are 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. The hours for organized activities are 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. Occasional rain-delayed or extra-inning softball games may be completed after 10 p.m. if already in progress. No new inning may be started at or after 10 p.m.
- 2. DRINKING** Consumption of alcoholic beverages on Recreation Park grounds is strictly prohibited. The Recreation Park facilities are defined as all areas within the Park boundaries. This includes all roadways and parking lots.
- 3. LITTERING** Littering is prohibited in the Park. Users are expected to police the immediate area after each use. Areas include picnic areas, playgrounds, pavilion, benches, dugouts, fields, paths, and courts.

- 4. VEHICLES** No motor vehicles (including motorbikes, motorcycles, ATV's, and snowmobiles) are permitted to operate on Park grounds or to use the Park grounds to gain access to adjacent properties. The roadways and parking areas are subject to the normal motor vehicle laws, such as observance of posted speed limits, licenses, insurance, etc. Only emergency vehicles or vehicles authorized by the Groundskeeper or Director are exempt from these rules.
- 5. PARKING** Parking is permitted in the designated areas only. Do not park in the areas designated for handicapped parking, emergency entrances, or pedestrian entrances. Parking is not permitted along Fruit Bud Lane. Only State approved handicapped or emergency vehicles are exempt from these restrictions.
- 6. NOISE** All users of the Park grounds are requested to keep noise at an acceptable level so as not to disturb the Recreation Park neighbors. **THE PLAYING OF LOUD MUSIC OR THE USE OF PUBLIC ADDRESS EQUIPMENT IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.** Abusive/profane language is prohibited.
- 7. RESPECT** All users of the Red Hook Recreation Park are asked to follow and practice all the common codes and principles of good citizenship and conduct. Please be respectful of the rights of others! Use common sense! Treat the facility with respect.
- 8. PETS** Please keep all pets on leashes within the Recreation Park; this includes parking lots and roadways. Please "clean up" after your pet!
- 9. GOLF** No golfing is permitted at the Recreation Park.
