Supervisor Sue Crane News Brief:

Dutchess County Department of Public Works has confirmed to Red Hook Highway Superintendent, Theresa Burke, that because of unstable conditions on a portion of Barrytown Road, a section of the road has been closed between the two driveways of the Unification Theological Seminary. UTS officials have granted permission to use the two seminary driveways for ingress and egress for those residents affected by the closing.

Red Hook Central School Transportation Director, Jeffrey Popp, has been apprised and bussing routes will be modified as appropriate.

Area residents are asked to avoid unnecessary travel on lower Barrytown Road while the county Road Closing advisory is in place.
