

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON  
PROPOSED ADOPTION OF THE

Notice is hereby given that the Town Board of the Town of Red Hook, Dutchess County, will meet at the Town Hall, 7340 South Broadway, Red Hook, New York 12571, on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2011, at 7:45 o'clock p.m., prevailing time, for the purpose of conducting a public hearing upon a proposed adoption of the Town of Red Hook Community Preservation Plan. The Town of Red Hook Community Preservation Plan has been prepared in accordance with Section 64-h of the Town Law and Chapter 57 of the Red Hook Town Code to establish a plan for the preservation of community character; to acquire interests or rights in real property for the preservation of community character within the Town including Villages in accordance with such Plan and in cooperation with willing sellers; and to provide a management and stewardship program for such interests and rights. The Town Board will meet to consider such proposition and hear all persons interested in the subject thereof and concerning the same.
