PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Red Hook on August 23, 2017 at 7:45 P.M. local time, at the Town Hall, 7340 South Broadway, Red Hook, New York 12571, to hear all interested persons on a proposed Local Law No. C (Proposed) of 2017 entitled “A local law placing a twelve-month moratorium on large scale commercial extractive operations in the Town of Red Hook”, to amend the Town of Red Hook Zoning Law to implement the recommendations in the Town’s Comprehensive Plan regarding resource protection, and specifically aquifer protection, water resources for public water supply, erosion and sediment control, extractive operations including soil mining, timber harvesting, and to study the secondary impacts of water withdrawal and surface extraction.
