

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON
PROPOSAL FOR INCREASE AND IMPROVEMENT
OF FACILITIES OF TOWN OF RED HOOK CONSOLIDATED LIGHTING DISTRICT

Notice is hereby given that the Town Board of the Town of Red Hook, Dutchess County, will meet at the Town Hall, 7340 South Broadway, Red Hook, New York, on the 23rd day of August, 2017, at 7:35 o'clock p.m., prevailing time, for the purpose of conducting a public hearing upon a proposal by said Town Board to increase and improve the facilities of the Town of Red Hook Consolidated Lighting District as hereinafter described, at which time and place said Town Board will meet to consider such proposal and hear all persons interested in the subject thereof and concerning the same.

The increase and improvement of facilities of the Town of Red Hook Consolidated Lighting District is proposed, consisting of acquisition of street light facilities including fixtures and arms from Central Hudson, and replacing the fixtures with light-emitting diode (LED) equivalents, and including land or rights in land, original furnishings, equipment, machinery and apparatus required therefor, and pursuant to the direction of the Town Board, Crawford & Associates Engineering, PC, engineers licensed by the State of New York, have completed and filed with the Town Board a report for the increase and improvement of facilities of the Red Hook Consolidated Lighting District, entitled "Report for the Town of Red Hook Proposed Increase and Improvement of Facilities for Existing Lighting District (LED Lighting)", dated August 2017, and the Engineers have estimated the total cost thereof not to exceed \$93,226.92.

The project has been determined to constitute a Type II action as defined under the State Environmental Quality Review Regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617, which has been determined under SEQR not to have a significant impact on the environment.

Said report describing such improvements is on file in the Town Clerk's office for public inspection. Following the Town Board's consideration of the increase and improvement of the consolidated lighting district, the Town Board intends to consider a bond resolution authorizing financing of such improvements.

All interested persons will be given an opportunity to be heard in person or by directing comments in writing to the Town Board, 7340 South Broadway, Red Hook, New York 12571. All reasonable accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities.
